ADDENDUM

RESOLUTION ADOPTED

72-143 Parking Prohibited on Township Roads.

[Note: Although the Trustees took action, October 26, 1972, seeking to ban all parking on all Township Roads, it was found necessary to pass Resolution 72-143 on that date on a title basis only, the text to be supplied by Legal Adviser Wiles. Mr. Wiles supplied the following text on November 9, 1972, pointing out to the Trustees that the effective date of the Resolution was dependent, not on date of passage by the Board, but by compliance with RC 505.17 which states that after the establishment of the regulation and orders by the Board, they shall be posted by the Township Clerk in five conspicuous places in the Township for thirty days before becoming effective and shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the Township for three consecutive weeks. It was indicated the effective date, therefore, would be thirty days after final newspaper publication of the notice].

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Painesville Township of Lake County, Ohio, have determined the public safety and welfare would be served by such regulation, and

WHEREAS, such regulations are not conflicting with the Uniform Traffic Act, and

WHEREAS, the regulations are applicable only in the unincorporated areas of the Township,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED and hereby determined by the Board of Painesville Township Trustees that parking on the Township Roads in Painesville Township is prohibited.
