TRUSTEE NOTES

The Painesville Township Trustees and Sheriff Daniel A. Dunlap signed a new contract for Sheriff's Department patrols on May 5, 2015. The new contract calls for additional road deputies and patrols in the Township. This agreement is a direct result of the voters approving a new police levy last November. The Trustees thank you and are pleased to provide additional police protection to our residents.

The Trustees, working with the Lake County Ohio Port & Economic Development Authority, the Lake County Commissioners and the Lubrizol Corporation have secured a major expansion at the Painesville Township plant location. Lubrizol plans on investing \$100 million dollars over the next five years and will add 25 new jobs. This is the largest investment in the history of Painesville Township. The location for this major expansion came down to the Township plant and a location in Texas. The hard work by everyone involved assured that the investment and jobs would stay right here in Painesville Township.

For the first time Painesville Township will conduct a free document shredding day for Township residents. This service will be provided on Saturday September 26, from

11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. It will be held behind the Service Garage at 558 Fairport-Nursery Road. Please see the August newsletter for additional details.

Your Township Trustees have worked with the Lake County Land Reutilization Corporation (the Landbank) to demolish four abandoned and dangerous houses in the Township. The Landbank is now building a park for our community at the corner of Sycamore Drive and Pontiac Avenue. Once construction is completed, the Landbank will donate the park to Painesville Township. We anticipate opening the park in August.



The second annual Painesville Township Family Fun Day will be held at the Lake County History Center on August 29, from 11:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Those who attended last year's inaugural event will remember that this is a very family friendly and fun day. TOWNSHIP NOTES

Painesville Township and the Fire Department are collecting winter coats for the Sub Zero Mission. Many residents know that the Sub Zero Mission is a local charity located on North Ridge Road in Painesville Township. This worthy charity is run by a group of volunteers from VFW Post 7939 based in Leroy. Their purpose is to provide warm clothes to homeless veterans during the winter months. (You can learn more on their Facebook page "The Sub Zero Mission".) Please consider donating winter coats that are clean and in good repair. Coats can be dropped off at Township Hall, or at any of our fire stations.

The Safe Routes to Schools construction project scheduled to begin later this summer has been delayed. At the conclusion of a three-week bidding period, no bids were received from contractors. We are currently working with ODOT and the County Engineer's Office to develop a plan to re-bid the project. This project will build and repair sidewalks in the vicinity of our four elementary schools and is being funded through a grant from the Safe Routes to Schools organization.

The fire department on Hardy Road will have the parking lot expanded using a permeable asphalt surface. This is being done with a grant from the Ohio EPA, in cooperation with the Chagrin River Watershed Partners. In addition to the permeable surface, the landscaping around the parking lot will be retrofitted to allow storm water to naturally filter into the ground, rather than drain directly into ditches and Lake Erie. A very nice green project for our Township!

Work has begun by the Metroparks to stabilize the shoreline along the Township Park facility at the north end of Hardy Road. This stabilization is in preparation of the pier and boardwalk the Metroparks will build in 2016.

And remember, all Painesville Township residents live within a few miles of 15 different Metroparks facilities.

ZONING NOTES

Five years ago, the Trustees made the Zoning Inspector a part time position. This made sense due to the slowdown in the economy. As construction and building pick up, it has become necessary to increase the number of hours the Zoning Department is open in order to better serve the public. The Zoning Department has added a new part time Zoning Inspector. We welcome Mrs. Harley DeLeon to the department. Harley previously worked in the Zoning Office of the City of Geneva. Welcome aboard Harley!

The Service Department provides a free brush drop off service to Painesville Township residents. The brush drop area is open on Wednesdays from 7:30 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. and on Saturdays from 10:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m. The brush drop area is located behind the Service Garage at 558 Fairport Nursery Road.

The brush drop area WILL BE CLOSED on Saturday July 4th.

The Lake County Utilities Department will replace the waterline on Larchwood Drive. The work should be completed by July 31.

Many residents use Vrooman Road to travel south to Route 90. Vrooman Road has reopened to traffic. The temporary bridge is one lane, and travel will be managed by a temporary traffic signal.

The Service Department reminds residents that it is illegal in Ohio to use electronic hand held devices while driving. Please do not text while driving.

Please drive safely and avoid distractions while traveling through work zones.



FIRE DEPARTMENT

SAFE EXCHANGE LOCATIONS

The Painesville Township Trustees, in cooperation with Chief Frank Whittaker, have designated all three fire stations as "Safe Exchange" areas.

The safe exchange areas are for residents to meet in a safe location for meeting people they do not know, make online purchases, and transfer children. The Fire Department recommends you drive by the fire station and verify that fire department personnel are in the building, and not out on an emergency call (the fire trucks are in the bays) before getting out of your car. The fire stations are located at:

550 Hardy Road
141 Bowhall Road
55 Nye Road

We always encourage residents to be safe and be aware of their surroundings when out in public.

ROPER KEY BOXES

The Painesville Township Fire Department is now a source for Roper Key Boxes to residents. Roper Key Boxes are metal boxes that measure 2 1/2" x 4", and are mounted outside a resident's main entrance. A key to your house or



condominium is locked inside the Roper Key Box. The fire department is the only entity that has a key to this box. In the case of an emergency, the fire department can open the box and retrieve a key to the main door of your residence. This way firefighters or paramedics can gain access to your house without breaking a door or window.

If a resident needs help, the Fire Department will come to your home and mount the box next to your main entrance. There is no cost to a Township resident for the installation. The Roper Key Box costs \$30.00. Please make a check payable to the Painesville Township Fire Department. To request a Roper Key Box, please call Township Hall at 440-352-1443. We will take your order for the box and forward it to the Chief of the Fire Department, Frank Whittaker. Once we receive your check we will schedule installation.

The Roper Key Boxes are an economical way for Painesville Township residents to help emergency personnel gain safe access to your home. Commercial and industrial businesses will still have to use the Knox boxes.
