#### **MINUTES**

The Board of Painesville Township Trustees met for a regular meeting at 11:00 A.M. on Tuesday, December 3, 2019 at 55 Nye Road. The meeting was called to order at 11:02 A.M. by Chairman Cicconetti. Present: Trustees Gabe Cicconetti, Chuck Hillier, Josh Pennock, Administrator Michael Manary, Legal Advisor Matt Lallo, Fiscal Officer Michael Patriarca.

Chairman Gabe Cicconetti opened up Public Hearing for Zoning Case 19-ZC-12, Rezoning of 1739 and 1751 West Jackson from R-1 to R-3 to build 5 duplex homes (10 living units) on 2.75 acres.

Legal Advisor Matt Lallo read the history of the Zoning Case 19-ZC-12 as follows. The application for this change was dated August 3, 2019. On October 31, 2019 the Lake County Planning Commission reviewed the case and recommended denial of the zoning change. On November 11, 2019 the Painesville Township Zoning Commission held a public hearing and they closed it on that date. On that same date they did vote and recommended denial of the change as well. The Trustees had a meeting on November 19, 2019 and received this case file and the Trustees where by motion they set up a public hearing for December 3, 2019 to address this case. On November 22, 2019 there was a legal ad published for this hearing on behalf of the Trustees.

Chairman Gabe Cicconetti asked if anyone was here to speak in favor of the change.

Mitchell Daniels the owner of the property gave a commentary on why he was for the change.

Tom Trivisoniano is the Engineer of the project for Mitchell Daniels and he gave a commentary explaining what they are proposing.

Chairman Gabe Cicconetti asked if anyone was here to speak against the change. No one spoke.

Chairman Gabe Cicconetti closed Public Hearing for 19-ZC-12 at 11:09 A.M.

Chairman Gabe Cicconetti opened up Public Hearing for 19-ZC-13; to remove child day care from the list of permitted uses in the CS district and to add that use as an accessory use in the CS district in association with a non-profit main use.

Legal Advisor Matt Lallo read the history of the Zoning Case 19-ZC-13 as follows. This case is requesting modifications 18.01A and 18.02A5. The application for this change was dated October 2, 2019. On October 31, 2019 the Lake County Planning Commission recommended a modification of the change. On November 11, 2019 the Painesville Township Zoning Commission held a public hearing and they closed it on that date. On that same date November 11, 2019 the Zoning Commission did vote and recommend approval as submitted. On November 19, 2019 the Trustees had a meeting and received the change request and set it for a public hearing for December 3, 2019. On November 22, 2019 there was a legal ad published for this hearing on behalf of the Trustees.

Chairman Gabe Cicconetti asked if anyone was here to speak in favor of the change. No one spoke.

Chairman Gabe Cicconetti asked if anyone was here to speak in opposition of the change. No one spoke.

Chairman Gabe Cicconetti closed Public Hearing for 19-ZC-13 at 11.10 A.M.

#### **DEPARTMENT REPORTS:**

- SERVICE DEPARTMENT: The Service Director reported that we have been getting the salt brine
  from ODOT for five or six years and there has been no charge. They would like to keep
  supplying the salt brine to the Township but they are asking for two tons of road salt. One ton of
  salt will come from Fairport and one ton will come from the Township.
- FIRE DEPARTMENT: The Fire Chief reported that Station 3 began repairs and they buttoned up the wall but unfortunately Wednesday night before Thanksgiving there was a lot of wind and the wind knocked a couple of more panels down. The contractor came back out to look at it but didn't feel secure touching the panels so they will have to come back out with a truck to secure it before removing anymore panels. The Insurance so far has covered the damage. The Fire Chief reported that 711 Newell Street is the address of the burn that the Fire Department is doing on Sunday. The house was donated to the Fire Department by Lubrizol.
- ZONING DEPARTMENT: The Assistant Zoning Inspector gave an update on the property at 136
  Woodworth Avenue where there were reports of someone living in the garage. Harley contacted
  the Sheriff's Office and the Sheriff's Office reported that the owner gave them permission to live
  there. Harley went out to the property to investigate and she sees no proof that anyone is
  residing there. The house has been foreclosed.
- LEGAL ADVISOR: Nothing to report
- ADMINISTRATOR: The Administrator reported that the Township is all set for our 7<sup>th</sup> annual Children's Christmas Party on Saturday December 7<sup>th</sup> from 11:00-2:00 at the Community Center
