Present: Trustees Gabe Cicconetti, Chuck Hillier, Josh Pennock, Administrator Michael Manary, Fiscal Officer Michael Patriarca, Legal Advisor Jeremy Iosue.

Chairman Chuck Hillier opened up Public Hearing for Annual Fiscal Budget 2021

Hearing none Chuck Hillier closed the Public Hearing at 11:04 A.M.

Various topics, agenda items and departmental matters were brought before the board including the approval of minutes from the previous meetings May 19, 2020 and special meetings June 5, 2020 and June 9, 2020

- The Trustees discussed Transient Vendor Permits that we issue in the Township.
- The Trustees discussed the Lake County Solid Waste Collection held at the Fairgrounds and the traffic jams that were caused by the collection.
- The Trustees discussed a CEI tariff that they want to charge for replacing street lights.
- The Fire Chief discussed the repairs at Station 3.
- The Fire Chief discussed returning the Fire Departments to normal shift operations beginning in July.
- The Fire Chief discussed a purchase that was made by a grant from Fire House Subs.
- The Fire Chief discussed this year's Lake County Fair being canceled so the Fire Department does not have to be present.
- The Service Director gave an update about a storm water concern on Melrose Drive.

- The Service Director gave an update about our road resurfacing projects throughout the Township.
- The Service Director discussed the Township's speed trailer that the Township purchased this year.
- The Zoning Inspector talked about a proposed small housing development on West Jackson Street.
- The Zoning Inspector talked about some issues at the Villa's at Lake Erie Shores.

2020-053 RESOLUTION THAT PAINESVILLE TOWNSHIP WILL PICK UP THE STATUTORILY REQUIRED EMPLOYEE CONTRIBUTION TO THE OHIO PUBLIC EMPLOYEES RETIREMENT SYSTEM FOR THE EMPLOYEES OF THE PAINESVILLE TOWNSHIP PURSUANT TO INTERNAL REVENUE CODE SECTION 414(h)(2)

WHEREAS, pursuant to federal and Ohio laws, the federal and state income taxes on a portion of the wages or salaries of the employees of the Painesville Township will be deferred if Painesville Township "picks up" (assumes and pays) the contributions statutorily required to be made by such elected officials and covered employees to Ohio Public Employees Retirement System (OPERS); AND

Whereas, Painesville Township will not incur any additional costs in the picking up of such contributions

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY PAINESVILLE TOWNSHIP OHIO THAT:

Section 1: Effective first pay in July(6/20/20-7/3/20 reporting dates) , the full amount of the statutorily required employee contributions to OPERS shall be withheld from the gross pay of each person within any of the classes established in Section 2 herein and shall be "picked up" (assumed and paid to OPERS) by Painesville Township. This "pick up" by Painesville Township shall be designated as public employee contributions and shall be in lieu of contributions to OPERS by each person within any of the classes established in Section 2 herein. No person subject to this "pick up" shall have the option of choosing to receive the statutorily required contribution to OPERS directly instead of having it "picked up" by Painesville Township or of being excluded from the "pick up" Painesville Township shall, in reporting and making remittance to OPERS, report that the public employee contribution for each person subject to this "pick up" has been made as provided by the statute. Therefore, contributions, although designated as employee contributions, are employer-paid, and employees do not have the option to receive the contributions directly. All contributions are paid by the employer directly to the plan.

Section 2: The "pick up" by Painesville Township provided by this ordinance shall apply only to the following classes, Office Manager; Service Director, Road Forman, Road Labor 1, Assistant Service Director, and Assistant Zoning Inspector of Painesville Township who are or become contributing members of OPERS

Section 3: The Painesville Township method of payment of salary to employees who are participants in OPERS is hereby modified as provided in Section 4, in order to provide for a salary reduction pick up of employee contributions to OPERS

Section 4: The total salary for each employee shall be the salary otherwise payable under Painesville Township policies. Such total salary of each employee shall be payable by Painesville Township in two parts: (a) deferred salary and (b) cash salary. An employee's deferred salary shall be equal to that percentage of that employee's total salary which is required from time to time by OPERS to be paid as an employee contribution by that employee, and shall be paid by Painesville Township to OPERS on behalf of that employee as a pick up and in lieu of the OPERS employee contribution otherwise payable by that employee. An employee's cash salary shall be equal to that employee's total salary less the amount of the pick up for that employee, and shall be payable, subject to applicable payroll deductions, to that employee. Painesville Township shall compute and remit its employer contributions to OPERS based upon an employee's total salary. The total combined expenditures of Painesville Township for such employees total salaries payable under applicable Painesville Township policies and the pick-up provisions of this

resolution shall not be greater than the amounts it would have paid for those items had this provision not been in effect.

Section 5: The clerk are hereby authorized and directed to implement the provisions of this ordinance to institute the "pick up" of the statutorily required contributions to OPERS for those persons reflected in Section 2 herein so as to enable them to obtain the result in federal and state tax deferrals.

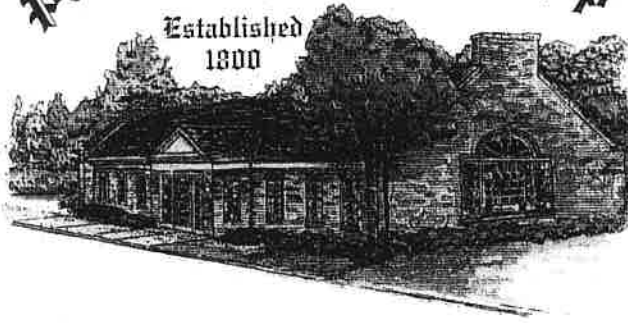

**Whereas**, the Board of Trustees of Painesville Township, Lake County, Ohio desires to pursue all reasonable and legitimate incentive measures to assist and encourage development in specific areas of Painesville Township that have not enjoyed reinvestment from remodeling or new construction; and

**Whereas**, a survey of housing as set forth in "Exhibit A" as required by Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Section 3735.66 has been prepared for the area to be included in proposed Community Reinvestment Area; and

**Whereas**, the maintenance of existing and construction of new structures in such area would serve to encourage economic stability, maintain property values, and generate new employment opportunities; and

**Whereas**, the remodeling of existing structures or the construction of new structures in this Community Reinvestment Area constitutes a public purpose for which real property exemptions may be granted.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED** that the Painesville Township Board of Trustees:





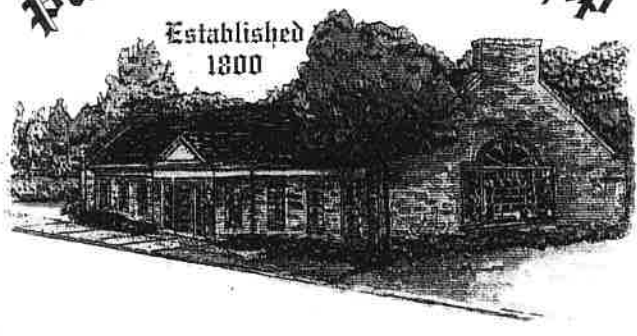

Whereas, the adoption of this Resolution was taken in an open meeting of the Board of Trustees and that all deliberations were open to the public in compliance with the law; and



### **RESOLUTION AFFIRMING PAINESVILLE TOWNSHIP WILL UTILIZE HB 481 FUNDS FROM THE CORONAVIRUS AID, RELIEF, AND ECONOMIC SECURITY ACT AS DESCRIBED IN 42 U.S.C. 601(d) AND ANY APPLICABLE REGULATIONS**

**WHEREAS**, the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act, 116 Public Law 136, (the CARES Act) was signed into law by the President of the United States on March 27, 2020; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ohio General Assembly established a process for distributing funds provided by the "Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act" in Senate Bill 310 of the 133<sup>rd</sup> General Assembly (SB 310); and

**WHEREAS**, SB 310 requires subdivisions receiving funds under Section 1 of the act, to pass a resolution affirming that funds from the County Coronavirus Relief Distribution Fund may be expended only to cover costs of the subdivision consistent with the requirements of section 5001 of the CARES Act as described in 42 U.S.C. 601(d), and any applicable regulations before receiving said funds; and

**Whereas**, Painesville Township is requesting its share of funds from the Lake County Coronavirus Relief Distribution Fund; and

**NOW THEREFORE**, be it resolved that the Board of Trustees of Painesville Township affirms that all funds received from the Lake County Coronavirus Relief Distribution Fund pursuant to SB 310 be expended only to cover costs of the Township consistent with the requirements of section 5001 of the CARES Act as described in 42 U.S.C. 601(d), and any applicable regulations and guidance only to cover expenses that:

- (1) Are necessary expenditures incurred due to the public health emergency with respect to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19);
- (2) Were not accounted for in Painesville Township's most recently approved budget as of March 27, 2020; and
- (3) Were incurred during the period that begins on March 1, 2020, and ends on December 30, 2020.

FURTHERMORE, in compliance with SB 310, be it resolved by the Board of Trustees of Painesville Township that the Painesville Township Fiscal Officer take all necessary action to:

- (1) On or before October 15, 2020, pay any unencumbered balance of money in the Painesville Township's local coronavirus relief fund to the Lake County Treasurer;
- (2) On or before December 28, 2020, pay the balance of any money in the Painesville Township's local coronavirus relief fund to the state treasury in the manner prescribed by the Director of the Ohio Office of Budget and Management; and
- (3) Provide any information related to any payments received under SB 310 to the Director of the Ohio Office of Budget and Management as requested.


