

WHEREAS as an applicant or potential recipient of federal funds this agency, Painesville Township, agrees that it will take specified actions to Affirmatively Further Fair Housing (AFFH) and confidently asserts that that all policies and practices adopted and in place are in conformance with applicable fair housing law and that prior to the CDBG/HOME application due date of May 20, 2022 that any outstanding civil rights matters are resolved in conformance with the most current published HUD grant eligibility documentation; and

NOW: THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Painesville Township Board of Trustees recognizes the broad duty to Affirmatively Further Fair Housing and the month of April 2022 Fair Housing Month in Lake County, Ohio.

A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF PAINESVILLE TOWNSHIP ESTABLISHING A LIMITED HOME RULE GOVERNMENT FOR PAINESVILLE TOWNSHIP, OHIO, IN ACCORDANCE WITH AND PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 504 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE.

WHEREAS, The Ohio General Assembly previously enacted legislation regarding the availability of "limited home rule government" to Ohio Townships; and

WHEREAS. The Trustees of Painesville Township, pursuant to Section 504.01 (A)(3) of the Ohio Revised Code, conducted a required public hearing on April 5, 2022 to consider the adoption of the limited home rule form of government; and

WHEREAS. The Trustees of Painesville Township have determined that the establishment of a limited home rule government will benefit the residents of Painesville Township, and the administration and organization of Painesville Township government and

WHEREAS. Painesville Township has a population of fifteen thousand or more in the unincorporated territory and would be designated as an "Urban Township" upon adoption of the limited home rule form of government:

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Trustees of Painesville Township, Lake County, Ohio, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the Trustees of Painesville Township, pursuant to Section 504.01(A)(3)(a) of the Ohio Revised Code, hereby establish a "limited home rule government" and "urban township" under which the Township may exercise limited powers of local self-government limited police powers as authorized by Chapter 504 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 2 This Resolution shall become effective thirty (30) days after the date of its adoption unless within that thirty (30) day period a petition is presented to the Trustees of Painesville Township that complies with Section 504.01 (A)(3)(a) of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3 That the Trustees of Painesville Township hereby find and determine that all formal actions relative to the passage of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of the Trustees, and that all deliberations of the Trustees which resulted in formal were taken in meetings open to the public and in full compliance with application legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

NOW. THEREFORE, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Board of Trustees and as further provided under Ohio Law.
