Lake County will experience a Total Solar Eclipse on April 8, 2024.

The eclipse will enter Ohio near Greenville in Darke County and exit Ohio near Avon Lake in Lorain county.

Lake County will have several 'prime' viewing areas with the center line of the eclipse traversing Lake Erie approximately ten (10) miles due north of the eastern and western boundaries of the county and the center line of the eclipse approximately five (5) miles due north of Mentor.

The total eclipse in Lake County will begin at 3:12 pm, and end at 3:16 pm.

Please remember, it is not safe to look directly at the sun with your naked eye, and sunglasses will not protect you.

Only view the eclipse with proper eye protection.
