# Coming in April....



#### Total Solar Eclipse April 8, 2024

Lake County will experience a Total Solar Eclipse on April 8, 2024.

The eclipse will enter Ohio near Greenville in Darke county and exit Ohio near Avon Lake in Lorain county.

Lake County will have several 'prime' viewing areas with the center line of the eclipse traversing Lake Erie approximately ten (10) miles due north of the eastern and western boundaries of the county and the center line of the eclipse approximately five (5) miles due north of Mentor.

The total eclipse in Lake County will begin at 3:12 pm, and end at 3:16 pm.



### Brush, Leaf and Yard Waste Drop Off

The 2024 brush, leaf and yard waste drop off program will begin on Wednesday, April 3rd.

The drop off area will be open on Wednesdays from 7:30am until 3:00pm, and Saturdays from 10:00am until 2:00pm.
